Roman Missal Changes in the Easter Vigil

The revised Missal has introduced not only a new translation but also new rubrics to events such as the Easter Vigil. What exactly is different? How will it affect our celebration of the Vigil this year? How should catechists and liturgical planners prepare?

Fr. Paul Turner is pastor of St. Munchin parish in Cameron, MO and its mission, St. Aloysius in Maysville. A priest of the diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph, he holds a doctorate in sacred theology from Sant' Anselmo in Rome.




He is a prolific writer. His books include *The Catechumenate Answer Book* (Resource Publications, 2000), *The Hallelujah Highway: A History of the Catechumenate* (LTP, 2000), *Celebrating Initiation: A Guide for Priests* (WLP, 2008).

A former President of the North American Academy of Liturgy and a team member for the North American Forum on the Catechumenate Paul serves as a facilitator for the International Commission on English in the Liturgy.
